What is that?

The “social wall” is a **public Padlet platform** where each participant of the Transnational Volunteer Jamboree creates a short profile card about their volunteer activity, which others can later view and vote on.

This will be the base of the **V4 Volunteer Award public voting**. After all the participants create their profile card (until September 15), we will open the voting to the registered participants so every volunteer can read the profile cards, choose the most favorable from each country and put a like to that. **There is an important rule: you have 6 votes. You can vote for one candidate from one country. You must not vote for yourself or other volunteers from your country. Only registered participants can vote.**

This social wall will be **publicly available** after the Jamboree so share information only that you feel comfortable with.

HOW TO POST ON THE VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES OVERALL SOCIAL WALL?

1. Before you create your profile card, please open and read our [Privacy Policy](#) so you can be fully aware how we will manage your data. Creating your profile card on the platform means you know and accept the terms.

2. Read the QR code or go to this link:

3. Click on the **+Post** button in the right bottom corner



4. Add your full **name**

5. Upload a **photo of your volunteer activity**.

Notes: you don't have to show your face, a picture of the activity itself is enough (see the sample). Other people's faces must not be visible due to GDPR regulations.

6. Add your **city**

7. Add a **short description** in English about **your volunteer activities**. The text should be about 3 sentences long, max. 500 characters.

8. In the left bottom corner select **your country**.
