PRACTICAL INFORMATION:

- 4-10 participants/country, who form a group and prepare for the event together with the coordination of the group leader
- preparation tasks for the group: creating a country card, collecting best practices, small presentation
- travel costs and insurance, accommodation and food are covered by the International Visegrad Fund
- accommodation in the downtown of Szeged, in twin rooms
- you can choose the 3 most preferred voluntary action in the registration form - after closing we will notify you about team assignment so you can prepare previously

- ✓ is over 18 years
- ✓ has at least 1-year engagement in volunteering
- ✓ has open attitude to work with foreign volunteers and get to know other cultures
- ✓ can communicate comfortably in English
- ✓ will actively participate at the Volunteer Jamboree
- ✓ is ready to take part in the preparation and communicate the experiences in the social media



The V4 Volunteer Award is a new initiative founded by the partner organizations to recognise the impact, dedication, and values of volunteers across the region, connected to the International Volunteer Year 2026.

As a participant, you become eligible for the award, and if you win, you can gain visibility and become a role model in your local community.

How it works?

1. Every participant creates a profile card on a dedicated Padlet wall. You can share your **name, country, city** and your **volunteering experience** along with a **photo**. This wall will be publicly available so everyone can discover the diversity of volunteer activities.

2. Before the Jamboree the participants can explore all the profile cards.

Voting methods:

- public voting: the registered volunteers can vote for one volunteer from each country (except from their own country)
- the organizations nominate one volunteer from their country

3. During the V4 Award Gala the selected volunteers will be awarded.

What happens if I win an award?

- We ask you to be an ambassador of volunteering from October 2026 to March 2027 in your country
- You tell your volunteer story in a short video during the Award Gala
- Later you can share your volunteer story in a creative way (e.g. post about your experiences, make short videos, participate in your local programmes...)
